## THE KAVLI FOUNDATION STRATEGY AND ACTIVITIES

Community building through regular webinars/online discussions. Connect Kavli Institute members and staff who care about, lead, or who work on engaging the public in science. Based on input from institutes, The Kavli Foundation will curate topics of shared interest. The foundation will also identify outside experts or peers to join select discussions to share ideas, research and best practices. Events will be a combination of webinars (experts presenting) and discussions (institutes sharing with one another, learning together, etc.). Some topical ideas already raised by institutes include:

- ▶ measuring and evaluating public engagement efforts
- ▶ public trust in science: discussion featuring pollsters who monitor trust and attitudes in science
- ▶ intersection of diversity, equity and inclusion and public engagement
- ▶ sustainable funding strategies for engagement programs

When in-person meetings are allowed again, the foundation will explore a Kavli Institute Public Engagement Assembly at the Kavli Conference Center.

Communications training/professional development. During the time of COVID-19, the foundation will coordinate an online communication training course by experts and scholars in science communication training. This will be open to any institute members and could have an emphasis on early career scientists. There will be a hybrid of instructional sessions to access during members' own time, in combination with peer group discussions and learning. We will aim to launch the course in Spring 2021, and we will seek input from institutes about communication training goals and attendees to tailor and design an approach.

Leverage financial partnership to build and sustain programs. For Kavli Institutes looking to create a sustainable financial model for public engagement programs, the foundation is interested in discussing ways to leverage the endowment, additional foundation funding, and other potential avenues to achieve this goal.
